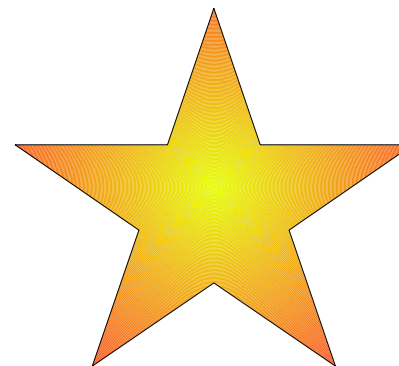

Registration & Program Information

How to Enroll: Please return the Student Registration Form with a \$20 deposit (checks made payable to BRYT, Inc.) to hold your child's place in class. You may also register online, by visiting www.BRYT.org/classes.

Availability: Class size is limited to no more than 12 students. For up-to-date availability, please check the BRYT website. We reserve the right to cancel any class that does not meet minimum enrollment of 6 students.

Attendance: It is important that students are present every day of class and arrive on time. If a child needs to miss a class or will be late, please call BRYT, Inc., at 860-0608.

Dress Code: Students should wear clothes and footwear that allow for freedom of movement. No skirts, loose tops, Crocs, clogs, or flip flops.

Student Showcase: All students may participate in the student showcase for family and friends. There is no admission fee.

Age Ranges: Please use our age guide when enrolling your child. Because acting skills vary by individual, BRYT staff pays special attention to make sure that children are in the appropriate level. Our staff will let you know if your young actor should be moved to a different class.

Confirmation: Enrollment will be confirmed by mail or email, whichever you prefer. Additional class information and paperwork will be sent prior to your first day of class.

Waiting List: If a class is full and you have sent in your enrollment fee, you will automatically be placed on the waiting list for any opening. If we receive a cancellation for that class, your child's tuition will be prorated. If no opening appears, a refund will be sent within a week of the class start date.

Financial Assistance: The application and instructions are available online, by sending an email to info@BRYT.org or by calling 860-0608.

Withdrawals: Withdrawal from a class must be made at least one (1) week prior to the first day of class and are subject to a \$10.00 cancellation fee.

Instructor Illness: If an instructor is ill and no appropriate substitute instructor is available, a BRYT staff member will call to let you know. The instructor will schedule make up lessons for any cancelled class sessions.
*Please note: make up lessons are not provided to individual students who miss a class.

Inclement Weather: If class is canceled because of weather, it will be posted on the web site and will be on our outgoing voice mail message. Classes cancelled due to weather will be made up at the instructor's discretion.

Class Descriptions

Tuition is for the full class session & includes materials unless otherwise indicated. Students will need to bring a notebook and pencil to each class in addition to the scenes that are provided in class, if any.

Creative Drama (ages 5 to 8)

Tuition is \$65.00

This class will focus on using the imagination to explore theater. Students will use improvisation, theater games, movement, and music to learn about characterization, story telling, and staging. Instructor: Neska

Creative Drama (ages 9 to 12)

Tuition is \$75.00

This class is similar to the above but runs slightly longer and is specifically geared to an older age group. A deeper understanding of character, and more complex improv scenarios and games will be explored. Instructor: Neska

Movement for Actors (ages 10 to 18)

Tuition is \$65.00

This class will help aspiring actors ages 10 to 18 explore basic stage orientation, spatial relationships, cheating, crossing, creating pictures on stage, physical warm ups, what to do with your hands, how to handle props with grace, and what our body language communicates to the audience. We will also go through some basic dance vocabulary... because you never know when a director will ask you to do a pivot turn. Instructor: Kira

Scene Studies (ages 13 to 18)

Tuition is \$85.00

This class will focus on bringing a playwright's text to life! We will use scenes and monologues from various sources to explore text analysis, characterization, story arc, your character's place within the story, line memorization, verbal and physical communication in context of the scene, and self-staging of a scene or monologue. Instructor: Kira
