CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Tuition stated is for the full class session and includes materials unless otherwise indicated.

Creative Drama for Preschoolers Ages 4 & 5 Tuition: \$50

We will use movement, music, nursery rhymes, theater games and improvisation to explore our imaginations and unlock our creativity. There will be a demonstration on the last day of class and students will have the opportunity to perform in our student showcase.

Storybook Theater Grades K - 2 Tuition: \$60

Using familiar stories to build our own play, we'll learn the basics of acting such as stage movement, vocal projection, and character work. Students will participate in the student showcase at the end of the session.

Introduction to Acting Grades 3 - 5 Tuition: \$70

Using short scenes, familiar stories, theater games and improvisation, we will learn the basics of acting including vocabulary, character development, story structure, vocal projection, and basic staging.

Interested students may perform in our end of session showcase.

Beginning Scene Studies Grades 6 - 8 Tuition: \$80

In this class, we will work on short scenes to learn the basic techniques of acting including basic staging, dramatic structure, character development, vocal projection, and an overview of the various "schools" of acting technique. Students will perform in our student showcase at the end of the session.

Scene Studies & One Acts Grades 9 – 12 Tuition: \$90

In addition to what is taught in the younger classes, our older students will work intensively on acting technique using established scenes or one acts to explore the various "methods" of acting. They will also costume their characters using items from home, provide their own props and set items from our prop closet, memorize lines and present their scenes/one acts at our student showcase.
